How did you hear about the site?

"I was searching on the net when I came across it. There was a posting for the position at LIFEwithBIRD so I applied with my attached CV and waited for a response, which was a positive one. Then we organised an interview."

What experience did you have before applying for this job?

"I started as a production and distribution administrator for Zambesi, New Zealand.

I spent two years there and then went to London for two years, where I had various jobs in the industry."

Tell us a bit about your job...

"My responsibility is to manage production, which is offshore. We have customers in Australia, the US, Hong Kong, Japan and a few in South Africa and New Zealand. I also meet with the designers and liaise with suppliers."

What advice do you have for people going for a fashion job interview?

"Do your research on the company and read the job description thoroughly so you can apply your knowledge and skills. Also, dress appropriately and spend a bit of time writing notes and thinking about why you are best suited to that role."
